



HOW ARE FELLOWS COMPENSATED?

Fellows receive compensation totaling over \$30,000 to participate in the Fellowship program at Eagle Rock. This compensation consists of a living stipend, room, board, a health care plan, a \$500 professional development account, and a post service education award. The stipend is \$18,000. Fellows receive individual health care benefits*, dental benefits*, a life insurance policy* and a post service education award of \$4,725* (*Contingent upon AmeriCorps funding). Room includes lodging in Willow, the Fellow House. Sleeping quarters consist of two Fellows per bedroom with multiple shared baths. Willow House also provides a kitchen, common room, study loft, and washer/dryer facilities. Board is provided in our Lodge for all students and staff. The food is appetizing and healthy with a variety of vegetarian and non-vegetarian entrees offered at each meal.

In addition to tangible compensation, Fellows truly receive a great deal more. Here are two perspectives from former Fellows about what they gained through their work at Eagle Rock:
